

Tournament Capital Centre Parking Improvements

The TCC parking stations work the same as the downtown parking stations except for one difference - two-hour parking is FREE for TCC and Hillside Stadium visitors. Registering your licence plate enhances the City's ability to manage misuse of the parking lot and improve parking for clients and guests.

Remember Your Licence Plate Number



From 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, you must register your licence plate for FREE two-hour parking. To remember your licence plate number, take a picture of it with your phone or get a complimentary KAMPARK wallet card and key tab from the TCC front desk.

Go to the Parking Station

Instructions

1. To start press
2. Enter license plate # and press
3. Available options: Hourly
Press
4. Press to print ticket.
5. Keep your ticket

There are five parking stations on site, including two inside the TCC lobby.

Need More Than Two Hours?



If you need more than two hours of free parking, ask the front desk staff for a parking extension. Time limits are enforced and violations are subject to fines.

Disabled Parking



Persons with vehicles with a valid disabled parking permit may park for FREE and do not have to register at a parking station.

TCC parking is available daily 5:30 am-11:00 pm. No overnight parking is permitted. Additional parking is available at Thompson Rivers University. University parking is free after 5:00 pm, Monday-Friday, and all day Saturday and Sunday. Please refer to TRU's parking policies for details.
